

Personal data processing information

Pursuant to art. 13 p. 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27th 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Dz. Urz. (EU OJ 119 of 04.05.2016, p. 1), hereinafter referred to as "RODO", please be informed that:

- 1) The administrator of the transferred personal data is the State Water Holding Polish Waters with headquarters in Warsaw 00-848, Żelazna 59A str., REGON [Business Registry No.] 368302575, NIP [Tax Identification No.]: 527-282-56-16; (hereinafter: PGW Wody Polskie).

- 3) Your personal data will be processed on the basis of art. 6 par. 1 letter b-c and letter e of the GDPR for the purpose related to the bidding procedure: **Contract 2B.2/2(a) “Flood protection of cities along Bystrzyca Dusznicka river: Polanica-Zdrój, Szczytna river Kamienny Potok”** conducted in the International Competitive Bidding procedure without prequalification, in accordance with the World Bank Instruction: “Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers” and from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development or the International Development Association January 2011, revised in July 2014, „Guidelines, Procurement of Goods, Works, and non-consulting services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and grants by World Bank Borrowers” January 2011 Revised July 2014; implemented as part of the **Odra Vistula Flood Management Project /Loan no. 8524- PL (hereinafter referred to as the "Project")**;
- 4) The recipient of your personal data may be persons or entities to whom the documentation of proceedings will be made available on the basis of World Bank procedures;
- 5) Your personal data will be transferred to third countries or international organizations (International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, Council of Europe Development Bank, European Commission)pursuant to art. 46 section 2 (c) of the Regulation.
- 6) Your personal data will be processed for the duration of the Project mentioned in point 3.
- 7) In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights:
 - a) the right to access your personal data, including the right to obtain a copy of this data (legal basis: Article 15 of the Regulation);
 - b) the right to request the rectification (correction) of the personal data concerning you - if the data is incorrect or incomplete (legal basis: Article 16 of the Regulation);
 - c) the right to request the restriction of the processing of personal data concerning you (legal basis: Article 18 of the Regulation);
 - d) the right to object to the processing of personal data concerning you (legal basis: Article 21 of the Regulation);



- 8) In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the Regulation (legal basis: Article 77 of the Regulation).
- 9) Your personal data will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be subject to profiling.
