## **NOTICE TO SKIPPERS No. 58/2021**

Re.: Opening of the Wrocław byway from the Szczytniki lock to the Miejska lock

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, 1901, 2170, and of 2020, item 284.),

The State Water Holding Polish Waters — Regional Water Management Board in Wrocław would like to announce that as of 8 September 2021, the Wrocław byway from the Szczytniki lock to the Miejska lock is open and its minimum waterway depth will be 70 cm.

The minimum waterway depth along the section from the Szczytniki lock to the Zwierzyniecki Bridge is 110 cm.

Szczytniki and Miejska locks can be contacted on Mondays from 6:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. and on other weekdays, Saturdays, and holidays from 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 p.m.

In connection with limited water damming on this body of water, crews of all vessels entering it are requested to obtain information on the current navigational situation from the operators of Szczytniki and Miejska locks.

Notice to Skippers No. 53/2021 is repealed.
