NOTICE TO SKIPPERS No. 43/2022

Re: temporary reduction of the minimum waterway depth in the ODW section from the Olawa lock to the Janowice lock

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1 point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 2233) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on Inland Navigation (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 1863).

"Polish Waters" State Water Holding Regional Water Management Board in Wrocław informs that due to the necessity to perform conservation works in the canals of the Ratowice lock, which requires lowering of the level of water at the Janowice and Ratowice weir, from 12 October 2022 to 15 October 2022, the minimum waterway depth in the Oder River Waterway section from the Olawa lock to the Janowice lock will be reduced to 70 cm.

We kindly ask all users of the Oder River Waterway to consider these conditions in their navigation plans.
