### NOTICE TO SKIPPERS No. 46/2022

**Re.: Permission for night navigation on the section of the Upper Oder River situated between the Opatowice lock and the Szczytniki lock in Wrocław**

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1 point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 2233) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on Inland Navigation (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 1863). and Art. 10.2 of the Regulation of the Director of the Office of Inland Navigation in Wrocław 1/2021 of 25 May 2021 on detailed terms and conditions for the safety of traffic and berthing of ships (Dz. Urz. [Official Journal] of Lower Silesia Voivodship, item 2550)

the "Polish Waters" State Water Holding – Regional Water Management Board in Wrocław, in cooperation with the Inland Waterways Authority in Wrocław, would like to announce that **since 15 November 2022 at 8:00 a.m. the section of the Upper Oder River situated between the Opatowice lock and the Szczytniki lock in Wrocław is** marked in accordance with Art. 5.02 of the Regulation of the Minister of Infrastructure of 28 April 2003 on navigation regulations on inland waterways (Dz.U. of 2003, No. 212, item 2027) and complies with the requirements governing the rules of night navigation.

Night navigation is possible only for vessels whose identification, lights and signals are in accordance with the Regulation of the Minister of Infrastructure of 28 April 2003 on navigation regulations on inland waterways (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2001, No. 212, item 2072).
