

NOTICE TO SKIPPERS No. 06/2023

Subject: Opening of the Downtown Floodway System in Wrocław from Piaskowy and Tumski Bridges to Mieszczańska lock

Pursuant to Article 14 1(4) of the Act of July 20, 2017 – Water Law (Journal of Laws of 2021, item 2233) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of December 21, 2000 on inland navigation (Journal of Laws 2020, item 1863).

State Water Holding Polish Waters Regional Water Management Board in Wrocław notifies that from March 14, 2023, from 06:00 a.m. the Downtown Floodway System in Wrocław will be opened for shipping from Piaskowy and Tumski bridges to Mieszczańska lock with a transit depth of 100 cm (Mieszczańska lock closed for shipping).

The above sections are marked in accordance with § 5.02 of the Regulation of the Minister of Infrastructure of April 28, 2003 on navigation regulations on inland waterways (Journal of Laws of 2003, no. 212 item 2027) and meet the requirements governing night navigation.

Traffic organisation on the Downtown Floodway System

- Under the Maciej Bridge there is one-way traffic downstream (no upstream traffic),
- On the section from Klara Isthmus to Młyński Bridge there is one-way traffic up the river (no downstream traffic).
- Wave generation is banned throughout the Downtown Floodway System and the traffic of craft without power drive is prohibited.

Notice to Skippers No. 53/2022 regarding the closure of the Downtown Floodway System is repealed.
